PITCHING YOUR PROJECT



Pretend you are in a lift with potential donors and have only 30 seconds to tell them why they should fund your school project. Use the information on your completed Planning Your Project form to create a 300-350-word project description. It is important for you to do this before logging on to our Fundraise Yourself crowdfunding platform as this description will make or break your fundraising campaign.

Tips to Create an Action-Driven Fundraising Pitch:



Make the donor the champion of your story. Use the words 'you' and 'your' more than you use 'l' and 'us'.



Stress the need for this project and the impact the donor's gift will have on your students, staff and/or community.



Always end with a call to action. This might be a donation ask or reminder about taxdeductible gifts.
